

Care and Maintenance

Your new door should keep safe and secure for years to come however with all products and especially those that are exposed to the elements we recommend that you carry out a care and maintenance routine.

- > Door frames should be washed with warm soapy water, however stubborn stains can be removed using specialist PVC-u cleaners and by following the manufacturers' guidelines.
- > The door leaf should only be cleaned using warm water or non-aggressive composite door wipes. No solvent-based product or abrasives should be used as these will damage the surface of the skin.
- > External glass should be cleaned with warm soapy water and cleaned with a proprietary glass cleaner.
- > Hardware can be cleaned with a mild detergent and wiped clean. No harsh chemicals or abrasives should be used.
- > Maintenance of the door may be required to maintain any guarantees from the installer. Hinges should be lubricated with engineering oil. Cylinders can be lubricated with Teflon-based products only, as other oils may cause degradation. If necessary, a small amount of lubricant can be applied to the moving parts such as letterplates, handles and knockers.
